Phonics & Reading

This term P2 children are working in their reading groups following their specific reading scheme. It may be Dandelion Readers, Storyworld or BigCats books. They are learning to talk about their books telling one another about the front cover, title, blurb, author and illustrator. They are also learning to make predictions about what we are reading and will all continue to use their reading book to complete comprehension tasks. Meanwhile P1 children are working hard to learn ferent sounds and are learning to use pictures to help them understand what is happening in a story. Ben Bear visits us all on a weekly basis to remind us to use our reading tools when reading. Every enjoys practising their sounds/ letters in a variety of exciting ways such as writing in glitter and sand or doing rainbow writing.

In P2 children are encouraged to be more independent in their writing through news writing and story writing (alongside other activities). They are also being trying hard to include VCOP in their writing. P1 are working detailed pictures about what hard to create they did at the weekend and are even starting to try and write about it. We will continue to use the Talk for Writing approach to writing and will cover a variety of genres throughout the year such as imaginative and non-fiction.

P1 children are learning to recognise, write, sequence and order numbers to 10 and are doing great work. P2 are learning to recognise, say and write their numbers to 100. We will be focusing on learning number bonds to 10 and 20 and writing number stories. We love active math games in Primary 1/2. We have enjoyed solving maths problems together and challenging each other with our mental maths questions. We are currently having fun learning all about 2D and 3D shapes.

This term P1, P1/2 and P2 came together and children got the opportunity to suggest topics that they would like to learn about. Every child then had to vote for their favourite and togethdecided on 'Animals'. I am sure the children will keep you updated as our topic deer we velops!
