#### **Ongoing Reminders**

#### School Uniform

It is lovely to see so many children looking smart in their school uniform. I would respectfully ask that all children come to school wearing school uniform. In very rare circumstances a pupil may require to wear alternative clothing for medical reasons. This must always be agreed with school management staff in advance.

<u>Uniform</u>: Sky Blue Blouse, Polo shirt or Shirt. Navy blue or grey smart trousers, shorts or skirt. Navy blue cardigan, sweatshirt or pullover (not hoodies). Dark coloured shoes for both indoor and outdoor school shoes.

## Not permitted: Jogging Bottoms, Hoodies, Branded Sweatshirts

We are also registered with <u>www.myclothing.com</u> who give a 5% donation to the school for items purchased.

## <u>Winter Weather</u>

So far we have been very lucky to have experienced a relatively mild winter. However, I would like to take this opportunity to remind you of the procedures for school closure due to adverse weather -

Closure before 9am—parents should check the EDC or school website/twitter for closure details. Websites/Twitter will be updated as soon as the decision to close the school is made. All parents registered for Groupcall will also be notified by e-mail. School closures are also usually broadcast on local radio stations.

Closure after 9am—parents will be contacted by the school as a matter of urgency. In the first instance, a text message will be sent to all parents. Also, for those parents registered for Groupcall an email will be sent. If you have a smart phone, it would be useful to have these sent to an e-mail account on your phone as this will give you instant messaging. Please ensure that you keep your contact details up to date with the school office to prevent any delay in contacting you in an emergency.

EDC has a twitter service which may be useful to parents during adverse weather. Their account is called East Dun Council @edcouncil click follow to receive information that is posted. Tweets will cover schools, roads, leisure, campaigns etc.

# <u>Parking</u>

Our school can become very busy during pick-up and drop-off times so I would respectfully ask that parents continue to use the appropriately marked bays to park in order to ensure the safety of all our pupils. Parking on the double yellow lines or zig zags, double parking and parking on the pavement is **unsafe and endangers our children**. We encourage all pupils to walk, cycle or scoot to school if possible or make use of the Sainsburys car park to 'park and stride' keeping congestion around the school to a minimum and ensuring a safer environment for our pupils.



#### <u>Dogs</u>

EDC has very clear guidelines in relation to dogs on school property. The only dogs permitted to be in the school playground at any time are guide dogs. Please note <u>any</u> dogs (regardless of size) being carried in to the school playground are in breach of policy also and will be asked by school staff to leave the school grounds and remain outside the gate.

#### Attendance/Latecoming

Can I remind you that all parents are required to contact the school office before 9.30am if your child is going to be absent from school for any reason. You will be asked to give an indication of how long the absence may last. If we are not informed of an absence we will contact yourself or an emergency contact number to confirm your child is at home. We take the safety of our children very seriously. Holiday absences are usually recorded as an unauthorised absence. If you are required to take your child out of school during term time for a holiday please send this information to myself in writing.

If your child is leaving class during school hours for an appointment please call the school office or send a note to the class teacher. An adult is required to collect them from the school office. Please advise the school if your child is expected to return that day.

Please be aware that as part of council policy, the attendance and time keeping of all pupils is monitored closely and correspondence will be sent out to parents/carers when this falls below a reasonable level.

## **Medication**

If your child requires medication during school hours, please deliver it to the school office and complete a consent form. Please check the expiration date of all medicine as it cannot be administered when out of date. It is the responsibility of all parents to ensure that medication is not out of date.

## Mobile Phones

We recognise that children may have mobile devices that they use on a daily basis and that they bring to school. In accordance with East Dunbartonshire Council's policy mobile phones will be switched off during the school day. Class teachers will collect-in mobile phones and send them to the school office for safe keeping during school hours. They will then be handed out at the end of the day. East Dunbartonshire Council will **not accept liability** for the loss or damage of mobile phones which are brought into school or the school grounds.

#### Allergy Information

Due to several pupils with potentially life threatening allergies, we are a **<u>nut free school</u>**. It is important that pupils do not bring nuts or nut products to school as a snack or in their packed lunches. This includes any products which may contain nuts such as hazelnut chocolate spread (Nutella). We encourage pupils not to share or swap snacks in case they contain any hidden traces of nuts. We also ask that children do not bring birthday cake to school to share with their class due to a number of allergies across the school. We very much appreciate your continued support with this matter.

Could you please keep the school office up to date with any information regarding your child's allergies.
